

# H2020 Contractors' Workshop on Bioenergy Market Uptake projects

## **Outline and Agenda**

## Target group

The meeting will gather together the following stakeholders:

- 1. Contractors of on-going H2020 CSA projects on bioenergy market uptake (MU) plus one Social Sciences and Humanities (SSH) project on bioenergy  $\rightarrow$  15 projects (one contractor per project, normally the coordinator or a beneficiary stablished in Brussels)
- Contractors of on-going Intelligent Energy Europe (IEE) projects → 3 projects ending in 2017 (one contractor per project, normally the coordinator or a beneficiary stablished in Brussels<sup>1</sup>)
- 3. INEA's and EASME staff

## <u>Context</u>

There are 15 H2020 bioenergy MU projects ongoing (including one SSH), 8 of them just started and 7 before the first reporting period. All these projects have many collaboration potentials as they may be working with the same raw materials, in the same regions/countries, with the same target groups, producing the same bioenergy carrier (i.e. pellets, biogas) or final energy (e.g. H&C), etc. Also, there will be 3 on-going bioenergy projects of the IEE programme having similar characteristics still running until 2017.

This event will be an opportunity to bring all these projects together so that they have the opportunity to meet each other, exchange experiences and information and start working on future joint activities and events.

## **Objectives**

The purpose of this workshop is twofold:

- 1. To make the contractors aware of what are other UE supported projects doing in the field of bioenergy market uptake
- 2. Triggering collaborations between projects with similar characteristics (by means of shared events, for example)
- 3. Allowing project contractors to gain tips and exchange experiences on how to communicate their projects and how to achieve the project impacts and results
